

**CURSO: O MUNDO PÓS-PANDÊMICO**

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**Ementa**

A pandemia do coronavírus/COVID 19 desabou sobre o mundo em 2020. Não foi evento inesperado, embora a necessária preparação para enfrentar tal situação tenha sido radicalmente negligenciada. Se a pandemia em si não causou mudanças sociais importantes, ela evidenciou e acelerou alguns processos já em curso em anos anteriores. Todas as facetas da vida social foram afetadas e o que testemunhamos agora, em meio a hesitações e contradições, é a emergência do mundo pós-pandemia, com desenvolvimentos desiguais nas diversas áreas da vida social.

O objetivo deste curso é pôr essas mudanças em questão, seguindo um alvo em movimento. Elas afetam o mundo em seu conjunto, mas de maneira variada, pois dependem da situação anterior à pandemia e como as diversas sociedades nacionais podem e estão respondendo a esses novos desafios. Evidentemente, este é o caso do Brasil também, foco portanto parcial de nossa abordagem neste curso.

A ideia de que a modernidade se desenvolve de acordo a certos arranjos que variam ao longo do tempo, definindo-se nesse sentido três fases distintas, orienta o curso de um ponto de vista geral, bem como a ideia de que políticas públicas demonstram tanto continuidade quanto mudanças “pontuadas” de maior monta. Será este último o caso da situação pós-pandemia? Pode-se falar de uma nova fase da modernidade ou de mera inflexão de sua terceira fase?

Note-se que o curso tem caráter eminentemente exploratório.
