The Institute

The **Institute for Social and Political Studies (IESP)** at the **Rio de Janeiro State University (UERJ)**, formerly known as IUPERJ, is a leading research and graduate studies institute in Latin America. **IESP-UERJ** was the first graduate school in Brazil to offer a doctoral degree in political science, graduating its first Ph.D. student in 1971. In the early 1970s **IESP-UERJ** added to its structure a graduate program in Sociology. Since the Institute's foundation, students have defended 332 PhD theses in Political Science and 255 in Sociology, 392 Master's dissertations in Political Science and 303 in Sociology.

In the 1970s, **IESP-UERJ** played a key role in the foundation of the National Association of Graduate Studies in the Social Sciences (ANPOCS), Brazil's largest and oldest academic association in the fields of political science, sociology and anthropology. **IESP-UERJ** also was a chief supporter of the creation of the Brazilian Political Science Association (ABCP) in the 1980s, and currently houses the ABCP's administrative office. **IESP-UERJ** is the institutional home for *Dados - Revista de Ciências Sociais*, the oldest and most prestigious social science journal in Brazil. Published uninterruptedly since 1966, *Dados* is indexed in ISI (Thomson Co), Latindex, ProQuest, SciELO, SJR, Scopus, among other indicators that confirm its high impact in Brazil and Latin America.

IESP-UERJ's faculty is composed of professors trained in universities in Brazil, Europe, and the United States, with research visits in Latin American, African, and Asian countries. The high quality of its graduate programs is closely connected to the multiple research activities developed at the Institute either by individual scholars or through the institute's **24 research groups and laboratories**.

Admissions

Since its foundation, IESP-UERJ has played a leading role in the Brazilian social sciences, thus becoming a reference center for researchers from Brazil and abroad, attracting international guests as lecturers, researchers, professors, and visiting students. Many foreign students have gone through our master's degrees and PhD programs, some of them with co-supervised PhD thesis. The institution encourages students from other countries to join its programs, and actively seeks ways to make the student's stay in Rio de Janeiro possible, through grants from Brazilian funding agencies or thanks to international agreements.

IESP-UERJ annually opens its selection process for master's and doctoral degrees in Political Science and Sociology.
